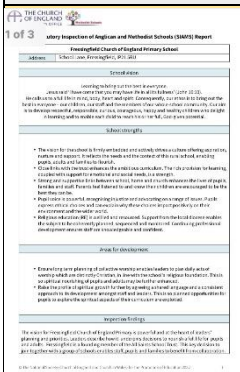


Cockfield
